An historic first, **Anthony Blades** Renshi and **John Burke** Sensei taught together over the weekend of Saturday 29th and Sunday 30th March 2008. On this occasion, Renshi honoured Sensei John by asking him to teach alongside him. Renshi arrived on Saturday and the session began immediately with our nervous candidates for Dan grades alongside the other Brown Belts and Black Belts. A hard grading session, including basics, kumite, kata, oyo, technical questions, and a

pressure test was endured. But of course, this is only part of the Black Belt test. Each of the Black Belts and candidates then had to teach in order to demonstrate their understanding and ability to perceive the problems that others have in learning. The class was relieved at the end, but



also knew that they still had the longest part of the course before them.



The Sunday sessions began with Renshi taking the class through the basics of "chambering" kicks that led to them performing ushirogeri.

When the kyu grades came to train, they were greeted by sweaty and tired Brown Belts and Black Belts.

During the session, Renshi and Sensei took the candidates to the side and gave them their results, one-at-a-time, with feedback for future improvements.
